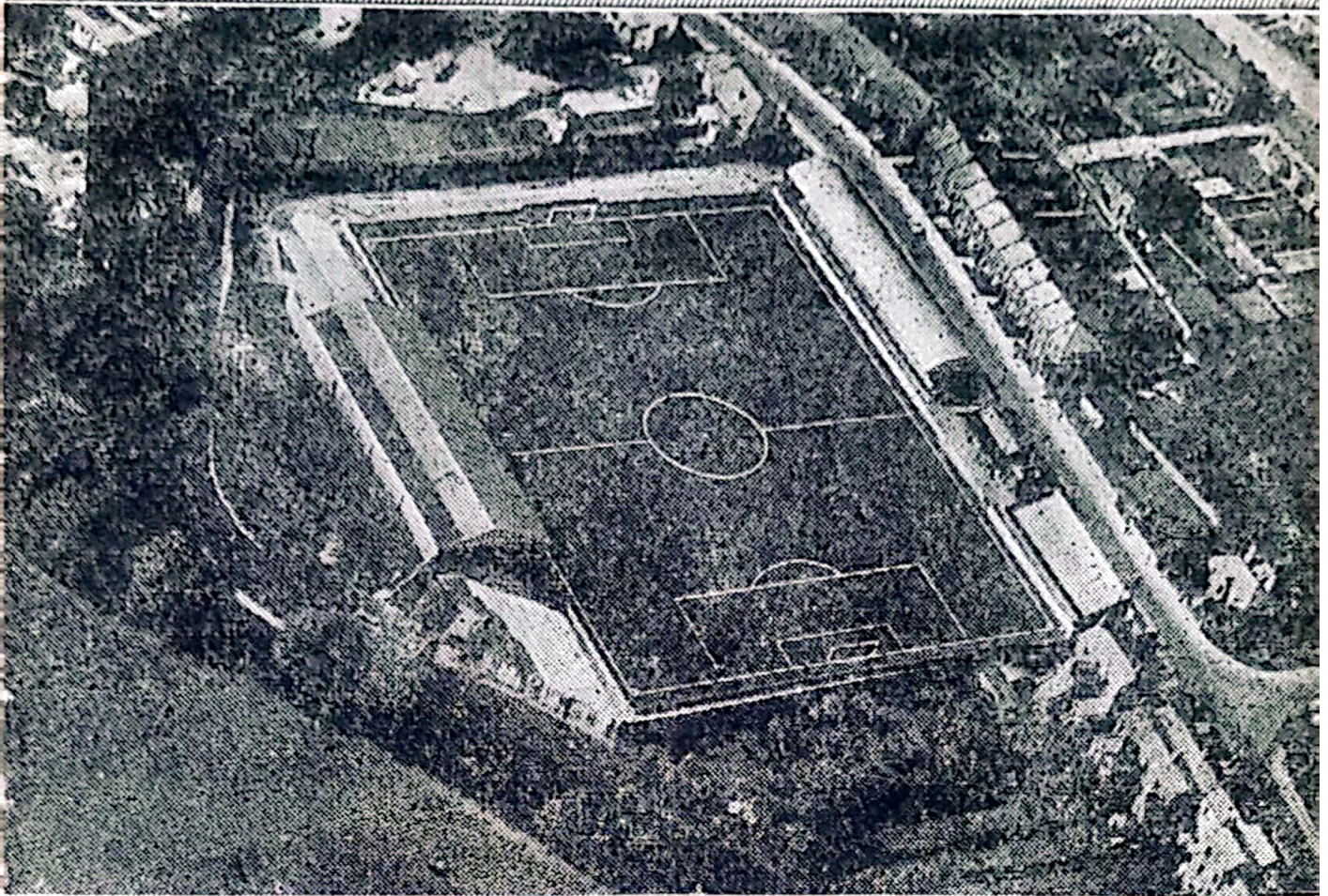

The Story of Hapoel Tel Aviv

THE Hapoel Tel Aviv Football Club, founded in 1927, has a record something similar to our own. When still the babes of their National League they carried off the premier trophy, namely the Palestine Cup, in 1928. In 1934 the club completed the double—the Palestine Championship and the Cup.

Before the war, Hapoel Tel Aviv went from strength to strength. In 1937, 1938 and 1939 they registered three more successes in the Cup; turning their attention to the League, they won premier honours in this competition in 1935 and 1938.

In 1956 the club engaged Mr. Iwan Yasbenzlk, ex-coach of Dynamo's Zagreb F.C., the Yugoslavian First Division team. He immediately adopted a new policy and got together a young team. Last season this team won the Israeli Championship, winning 13 games, losing 3 and drawing 2. As a direct result of this fine performance, Hapoel Tel Aviv are now sometimes known as the "Busby Babes of Israel"—average age of the team, 20, seven of whom are members of the present Israeli National team!

Their full record since promotion:—League Champions—1934, 1935, 1938, 1943 and 1957. Cup Winners—1928, 1934, 1937, 1938 and 1939.

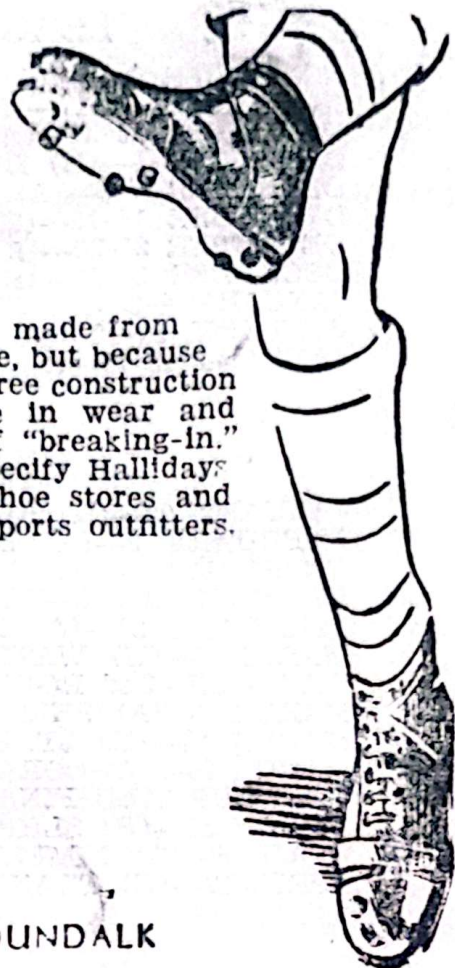
